Information note for the holder of an FFAM passport

You hold a passport issued by the FFAM. Its validity period is as follows:

- Casual non-resident passport: a calendar year
- Competitive non-resident passport: a calendar year

Each passport comes with FFAM group insurance coverage, which includes civil liability insurance.

The following tables provide the amounts of guarantees. There is no deductible on the guaranteed amounts. The amounts shown are those in effect since September 1, 2021. If these amounts are not considered sufficient, the holder of the passport has the possibility to purchase additional insurance from the insurer of his choice.

In the event of an accident, the president of the association that issued the passport should be contacted to draw up the declaration of loss which must be sent to the FFAM within 5 days.

MODEL AIRCRAFT CATEGORIES

(cf. Decree of 17 December 2015 on the design of civil aircraft operating without any persons on board, the conditions of their employment and the required abilities of the persons using them).

Category A: model aircraft with a maximum take-off weight of less than 25 kg with a limitation for each type of propulsion. An A Category model aircraft doesn't have to be declared or to be pre-approved for flight.

Category B: any aircraft that does not match the characteristics of an A category model aircraft. A B category model aircraft is subject to a flight authorization issued by the DGAC.
